# Dip a Rainbow

### Science Experiment



#### Method

- Before you begin the activity cut the black paper in to small squares, approximately 10cm in length.
- 2. Fill the bowl half full with water.
- To carry out the activity, add two drops of clear nail varnish to the water.
- 4. Immediately dip the paper square into the liquid, remove it, and leave it to dry.
- 5. Hold the paper up to the window to see the colours on the paper.

\*Note: the nail varnish will dry quickly, causing a film on top of the water. To do this experiment successfully, you will have to work quickly.

#### You will need:

Clear nail polish

Black paper

Water

Bowl
